Thank you for all your support within the past year as we fulfill our vision. Here are our highlights for this year.

BIRTH OF LMC CALGARY

- We started LMC here in Calgary on November 15, 2020. Glory to God.
- We started with 12 families and now were counting and growing.

5 ADDITIONAL CHURCHES/OUTREACH

- We added 5 more churches/ outreach in 3 different provinces of the Philippines.
- Three churches in Palawan under Pastor Paul Tumulak, another one in Cagayan Valley with Pastor Elladia Vallejo, lastly one in Isabela under Pastor Tom Canceran.

CHURCH BUILDING

 This year we started a new church building in Isabela and Nueva Vizcaya, including our main church in La Union, that will include a church, office, pastoral house and bible school.

48 BOXES OF GOODS


 We sent 48 boxes of goods to our churches/outreaches in 9 different Philippine provinces.

OVER 3,000 APPLES

 We gave away over 3,000 apples in all our churches/ outreaches in the Philippines for our Annual Christmas apple drive.

PASTORAL HOUSE & WATER FILTRATION

• We also build a pastoral house and a water filtration building in La Union. The water filtration system will be installed in the fall as the funds come. It will bring clean water to hundreds of poor families. It will benefit the children especially because it will eliminate water borne diseases coming from the dirty water that they are drinking. Rotary Club of Calgary Millennium donated \$10,000 towards this project which was used to build the building. Please help us raise \$6,500 for the water filtration system.

All churches are flourishing, and we continue to mentor and lead them through Zoom meeting every Monday. We also hold a monthly meeting with all our main pastors for reporting, to address all concerns in every location and to pray for all their needs. We believe that building relationship is very essential to any ministry. So, we continuously walk with them in there spiritual lives, encourage them, teach them sound doctrine and admonish them if necessary.

Every month we send four boxes to four different churches/outreaches to help them out not only for the ministry but for their family's needs as well. Pastors receives the 45% gross church tithes and offerings to support them financially. In addition to this, LMS sends a monthly allowance for all main workers and leaders to add for assistance for their transportation to visit outreaches and to reach out to families who need counselling in their area.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Treasurer's Report

The total revenue of Lighthouse Missions Society (LMS) for the fiscal year April 2020 to March 2021 was \$99,000. This amount was 27% higher than the revenue for the prior fiscal year of \$78,000.

The total revenue is broken down into \$88,000 donation income, \$9,000 gifts from other registered charities like Eastside City Church, United Way & Canada Helps and \$2,000 income from fundraising.

The donation income of \$88,000 this fiscal year was 45% higher than donations from the prior fiscal year. This increase was mainly due to the launching of the Lighthouse Missions Church (LMC) in November 2020. Donation income since the launch of LMC averaged around \$12,000 per month; this amount doubled the monthly average of \$6,000 for the ten - month period prior to the launch of the church.

The total expenses for the fiscal year was \$71,000; this amount was higher by 11% compared to the total expenses of the prior fiscal year. Around 56% of the total expenses this year was attributable to the opening of LMC consisting of salaries, rent, equipment and software. Mission expenses, mainly provided to Lighthouse Missions Ministry Philippines Inc. (LMMPI), accounted for 33% of the total expenses this fiscal year.

Last year, mission giving to LMMPI accounted for 70% of total expenses. Out of the 70%, 44% or \$28,000 was used to finance the ongoing construction of a church building, office and school for LMMPI.

We praise the Lord for his faithfulness to LMS.

Thank you for the privilege of serving as Treasurer of LMS for the past four years. May the Lord continue to bless LMS and LMC.

OUR GOALS FOR 2021

- To raise more committed leaders and participate to the success of our ministry.
- To find a Youth Leader who will guide and mentor our youth.
- To encourage more families to join our ministry as God expand our territories.
- To help raise funds for our main church building in the Philippines which will include a church, office, pastoral house and bible school.
